

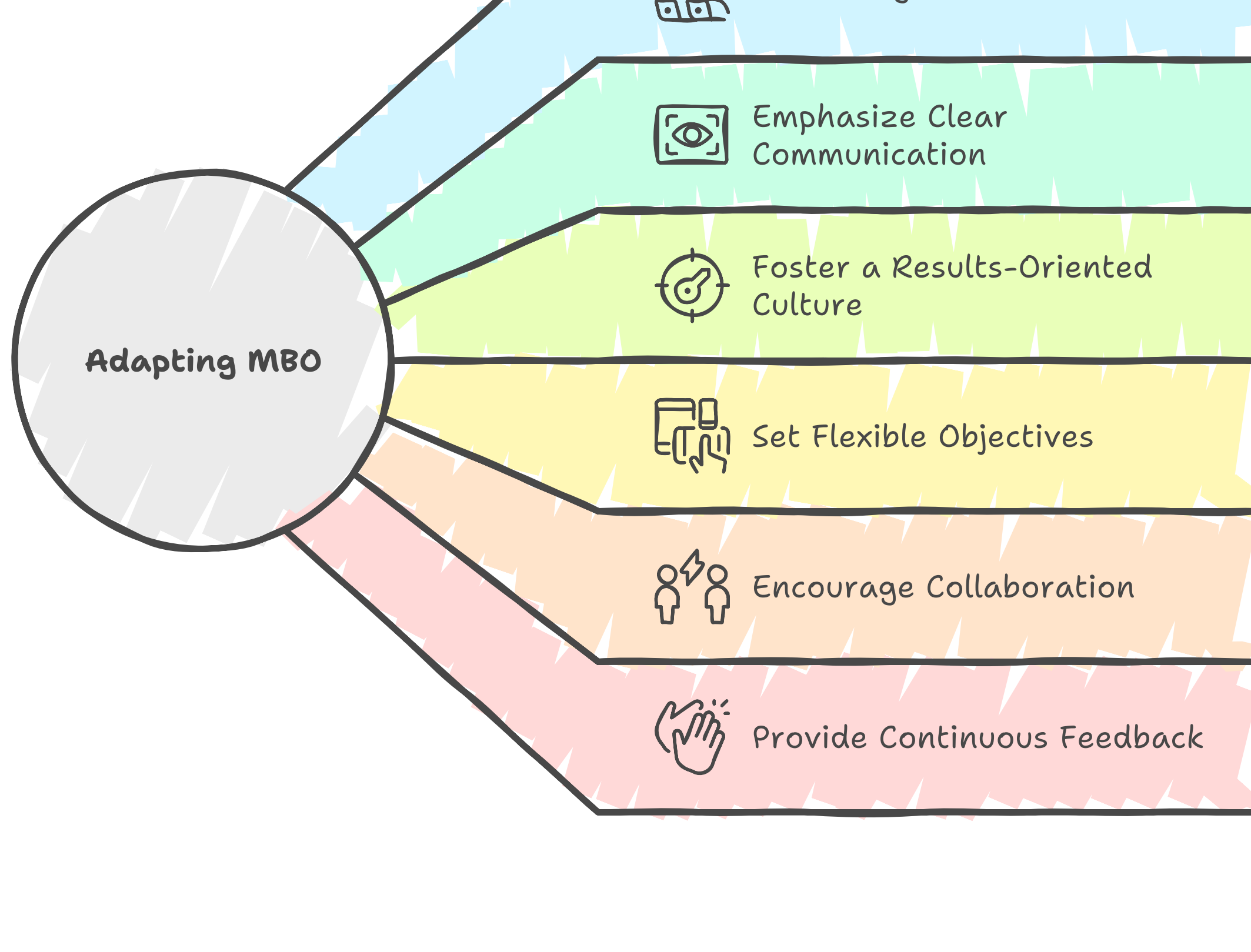

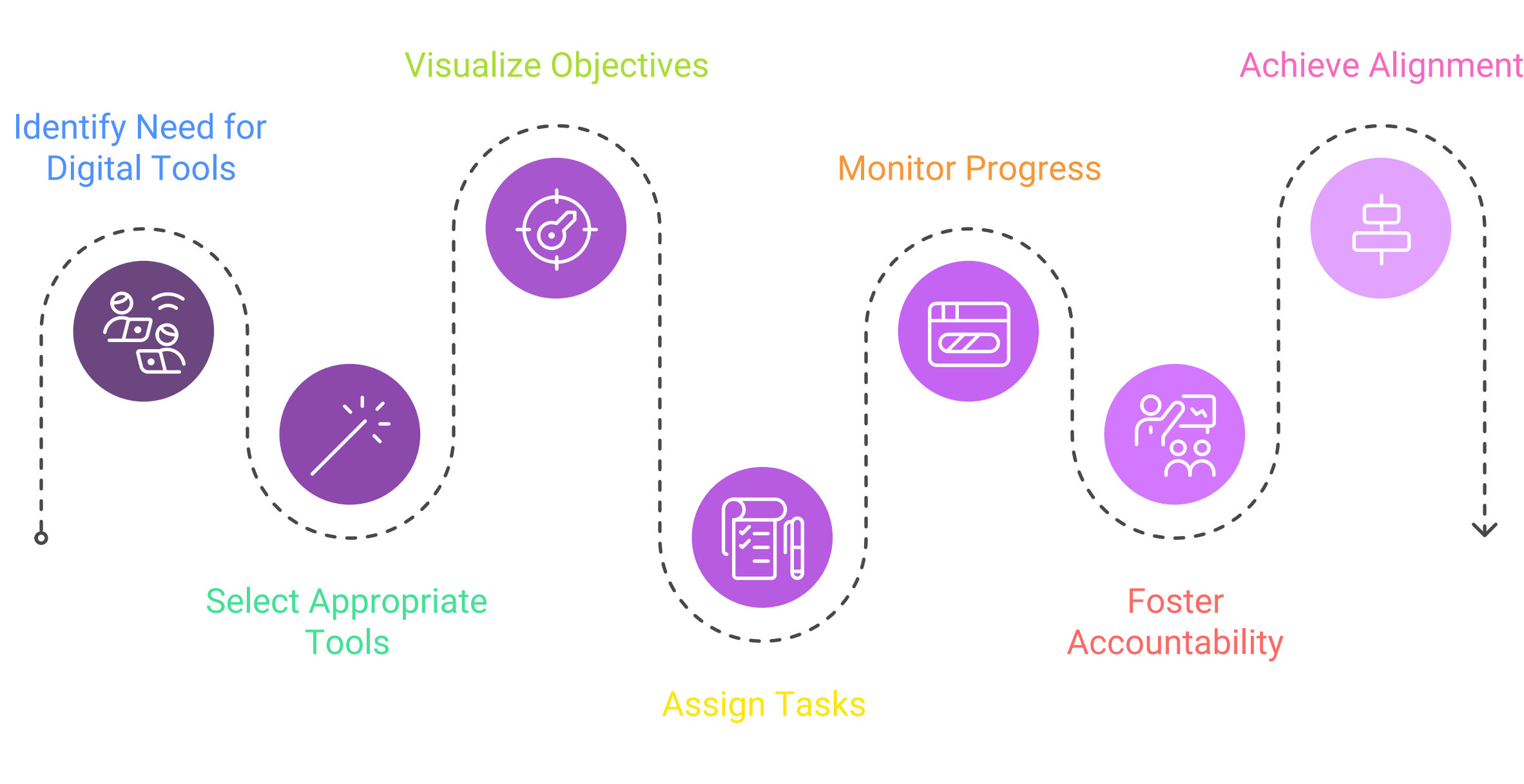

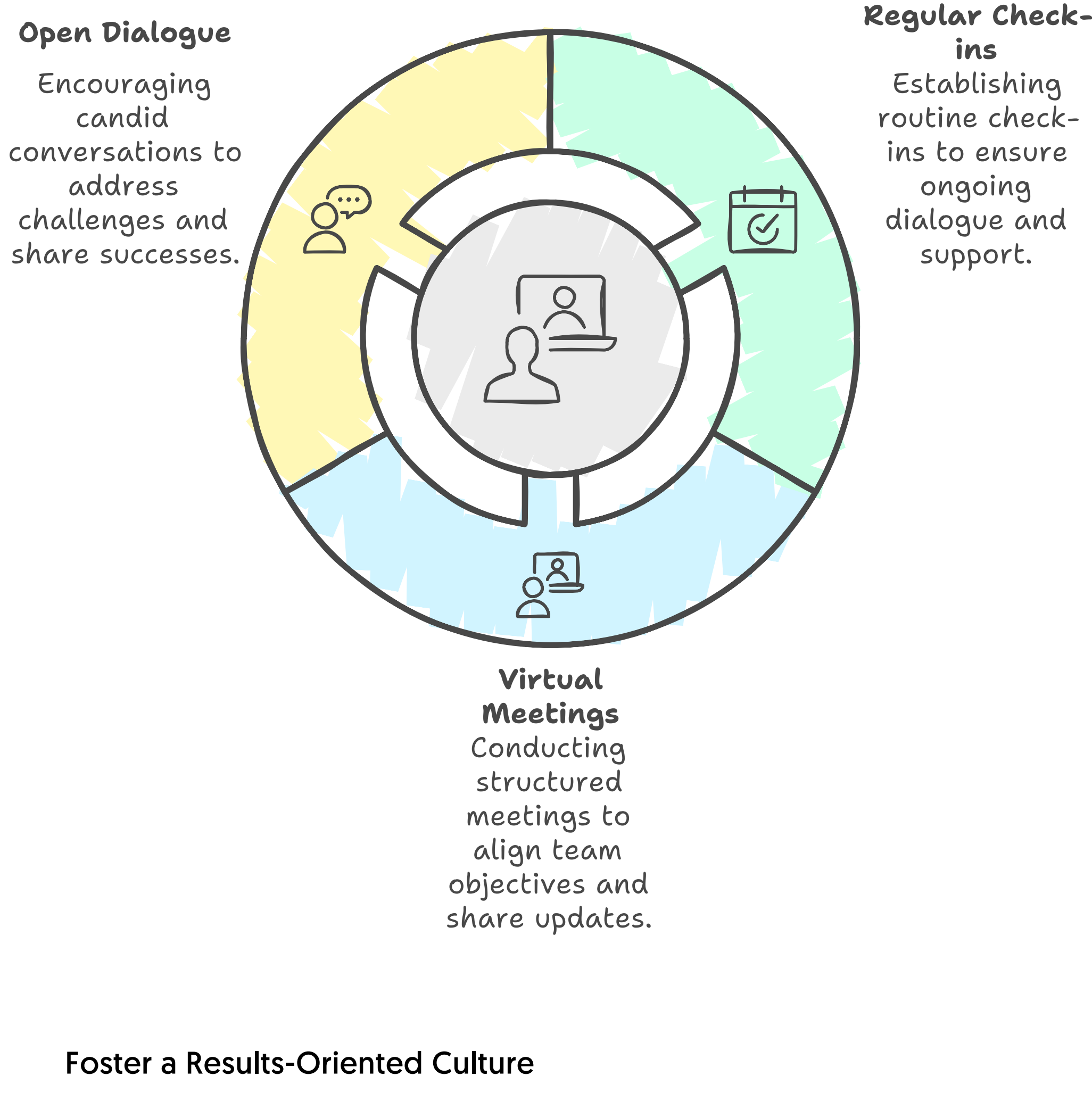
Digital Goal Setting and Tracking in Remote Work
