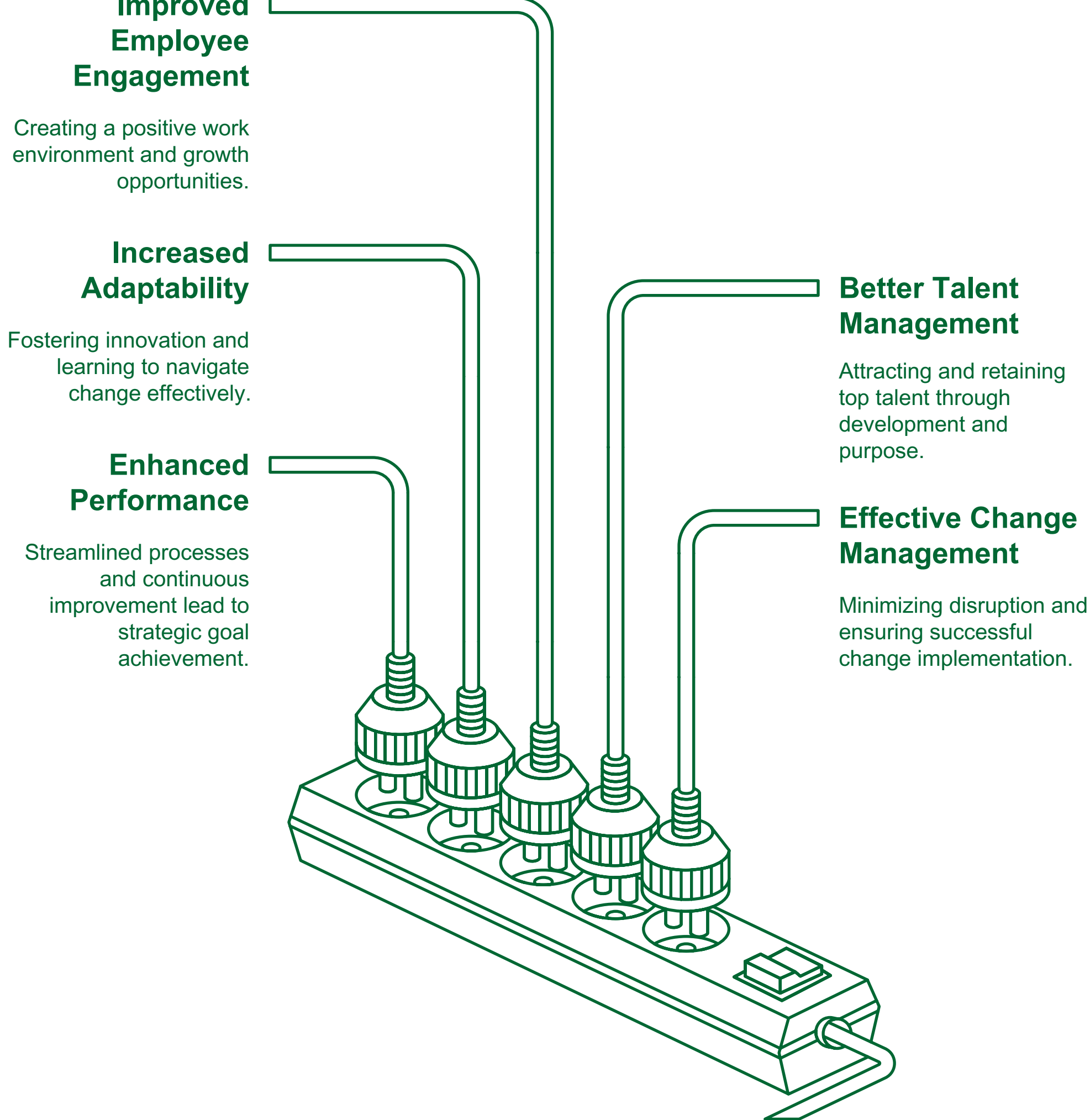

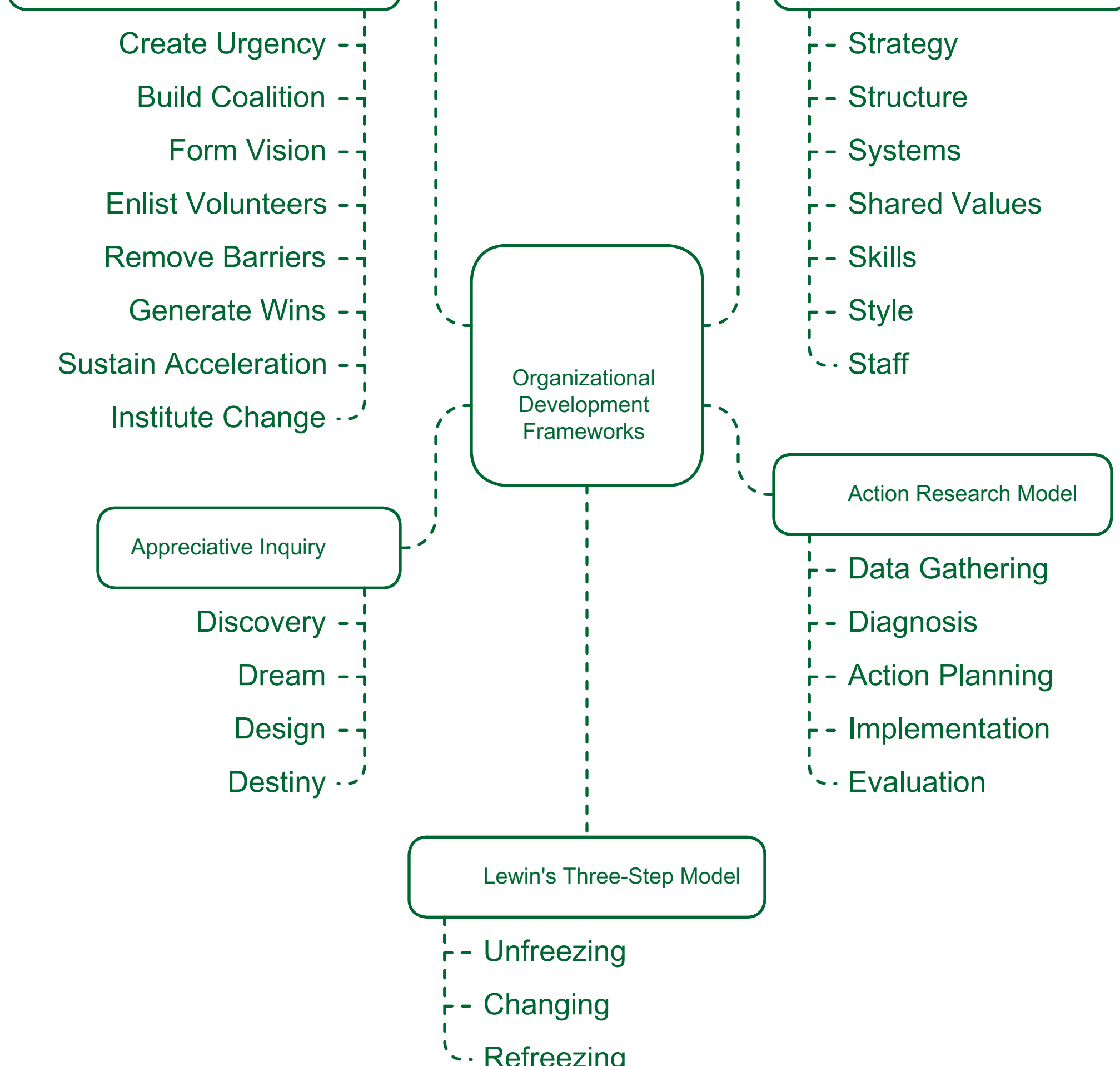


Key Organizational Development Frameworks

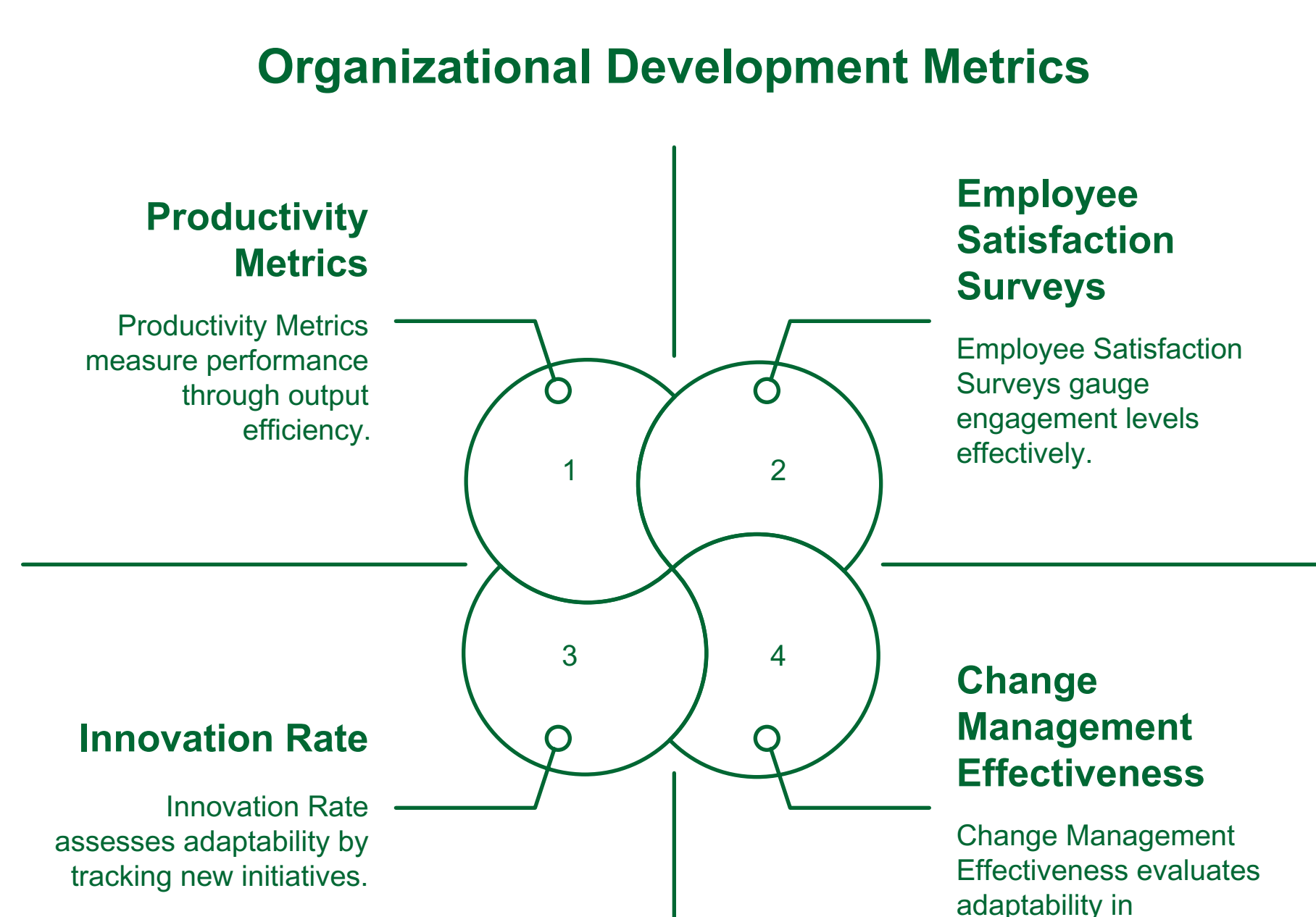

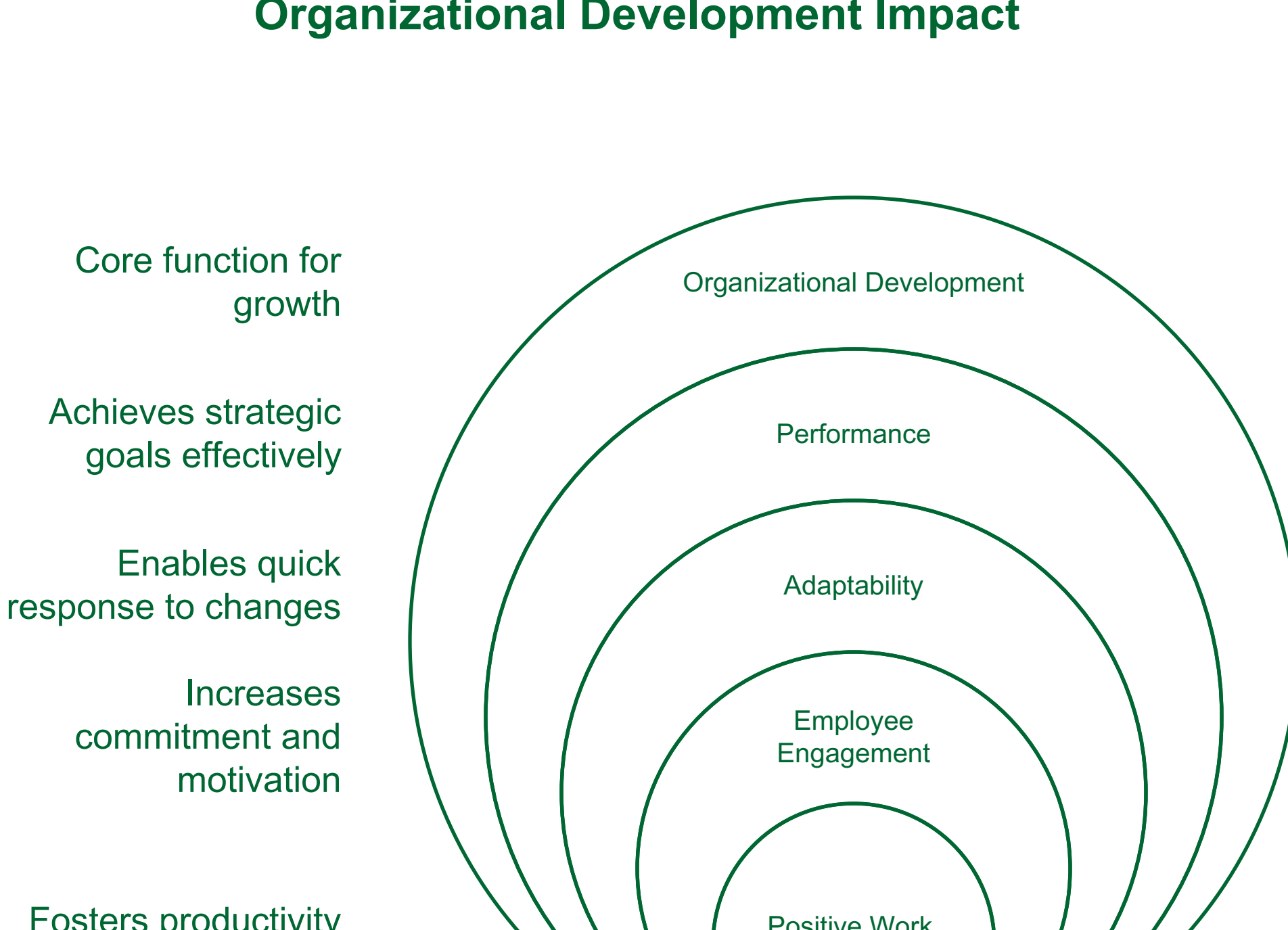
